2 Safety

Failure to follow these instructions may have serious consequences, such as the destruction of the device, personal injury or death due to electric shock. 2.1 Position and Securing

NOTICE

- If positioning in a closed environment, make sure the area is ventilated and allows regular recirculation of air. If installing in an open environment, position the enclosure in an area that is constantly shaded and protected from exposure to direct sunlight. These measures are important for preventing unnecessary and excessive overheating, which prolonged in time impairs the duration and operation of parts inserted inside.
- Make sure the wall where the enclosure is to be mounted is suitable to support the weight. The weight is around 8 kg.
- Verify the Combiner Box's IP65 rating meets environmental requirements.

2.2 Safety Precautions

This section contains safety precautions that must be observed at all times when working on or with the product. To prevent personal injury and property damage and to ensure long-term operation of the product, read this section carefully and follow all safety precautions at all times.

- Cover or isolate any adjacent live components. Protective covers must always be mounted.

Touching live DC cables from batteries or an inverter results in death or serious injury.

- Prior to connecting the DC cables, ensure that the DC cables are voltage-free.
- Wear suitable personal protective equipment when working on the Combiner Box.

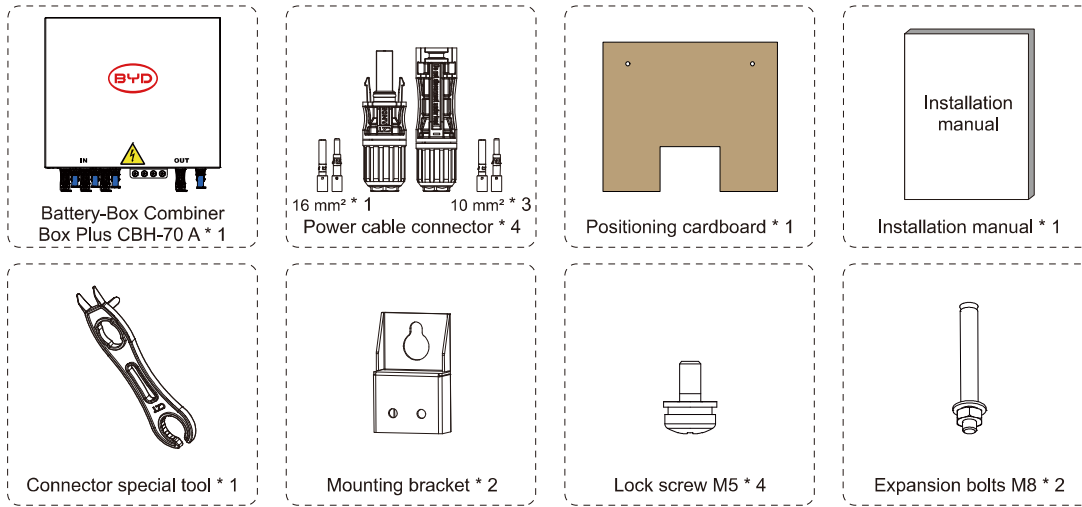
Danger to life from electric shock if the Combiner Box is damaged

- Make sure that all safety equipment is in good working order.

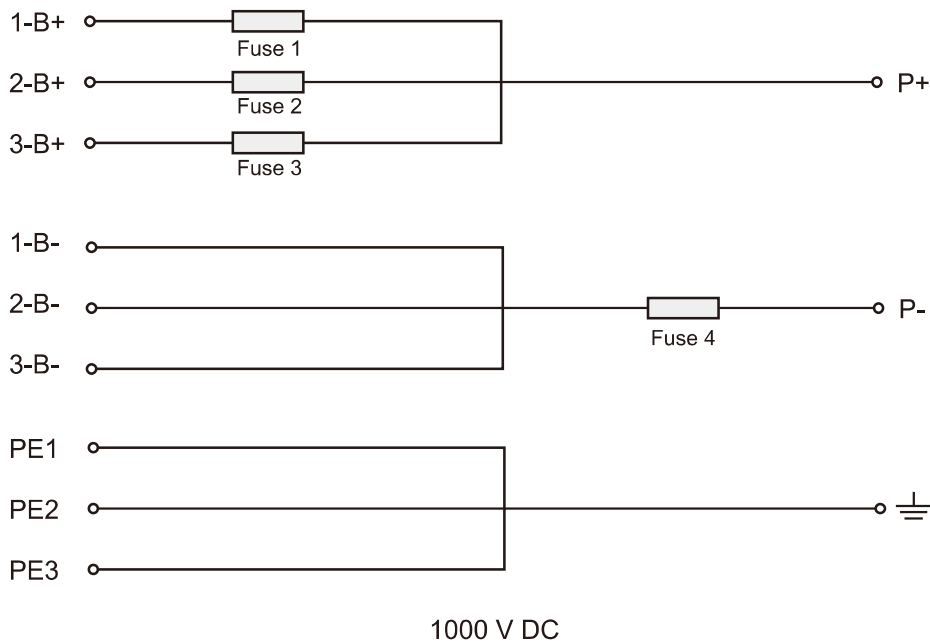
3 Scope of Delivery

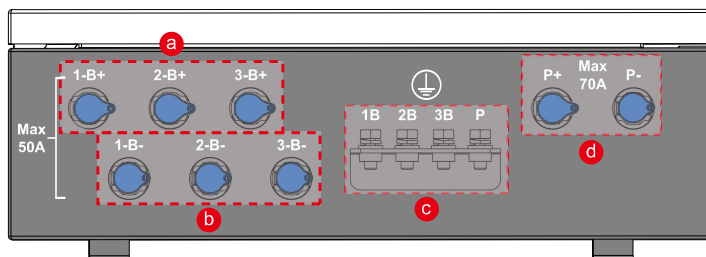

4.1 Circuit Diagram

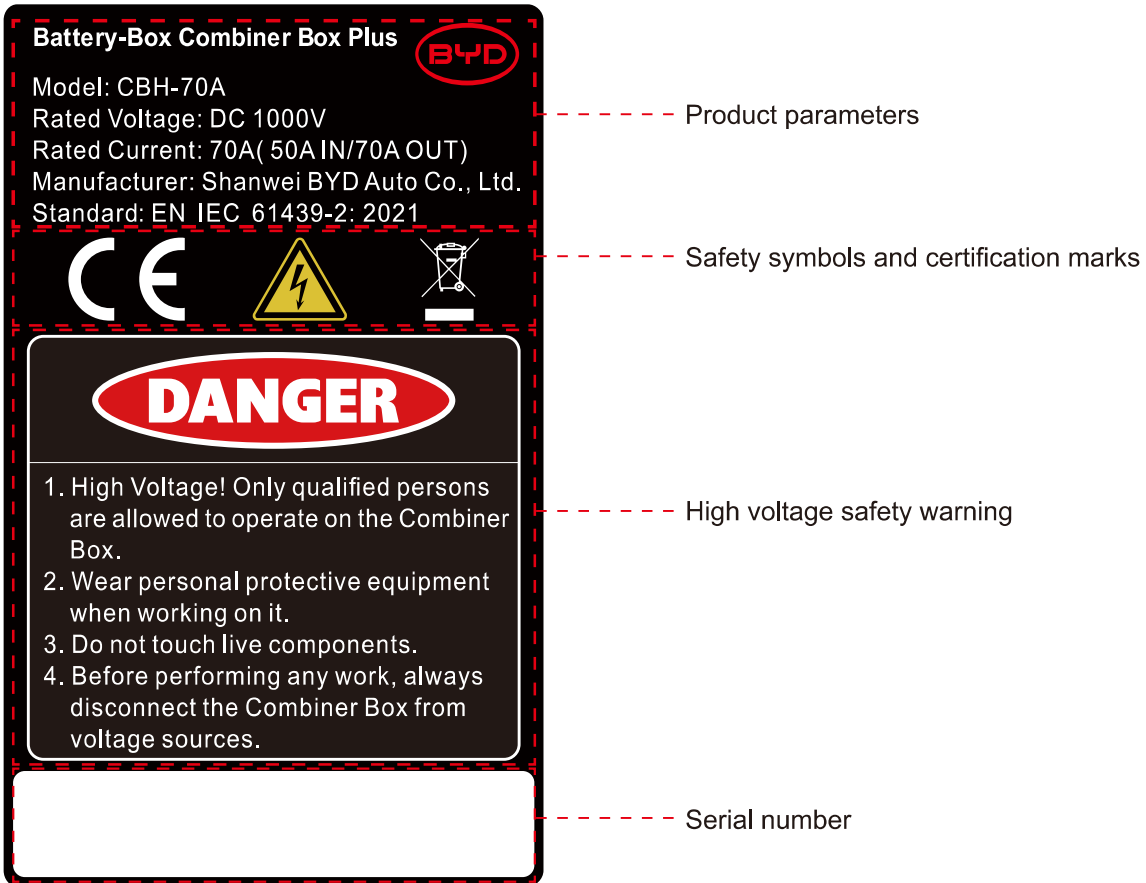

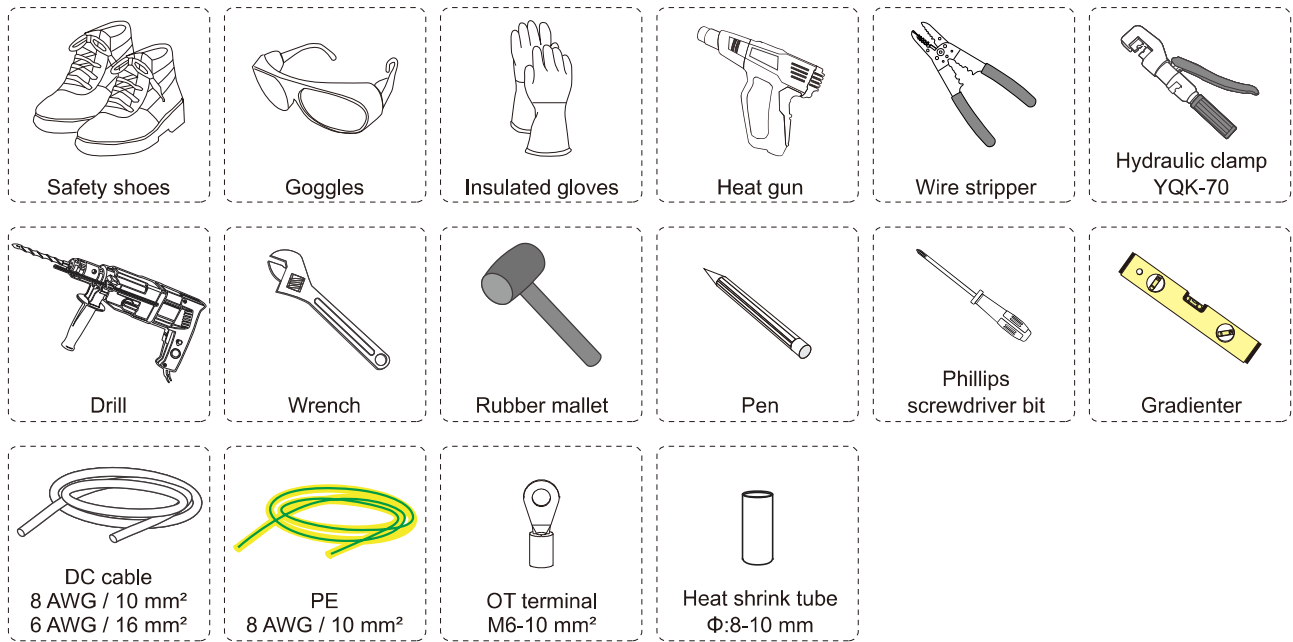

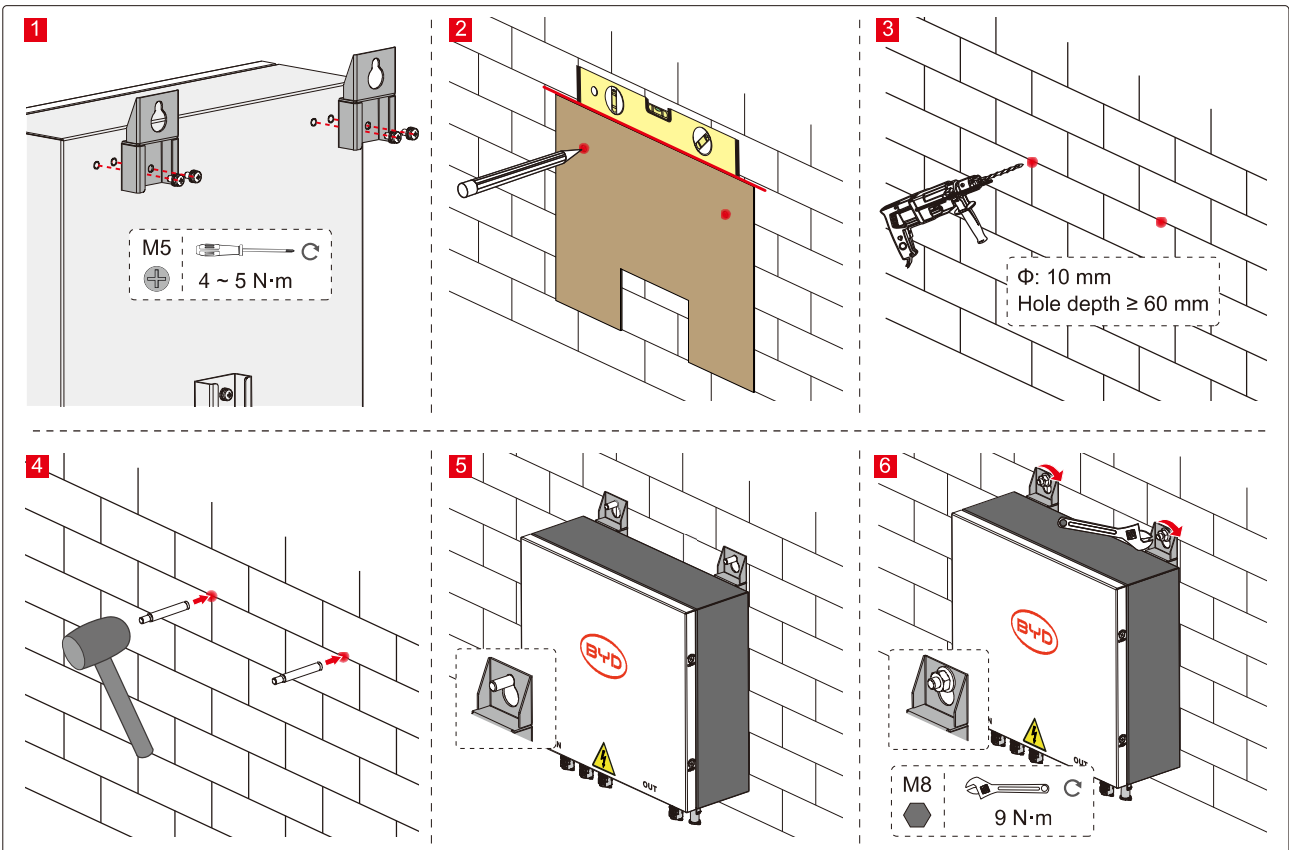

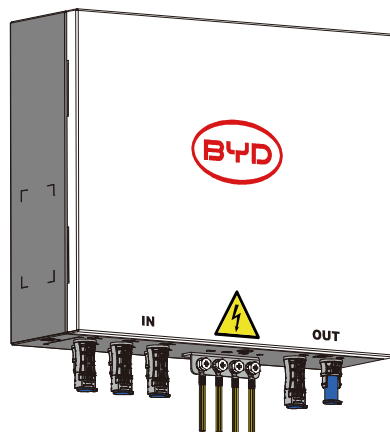

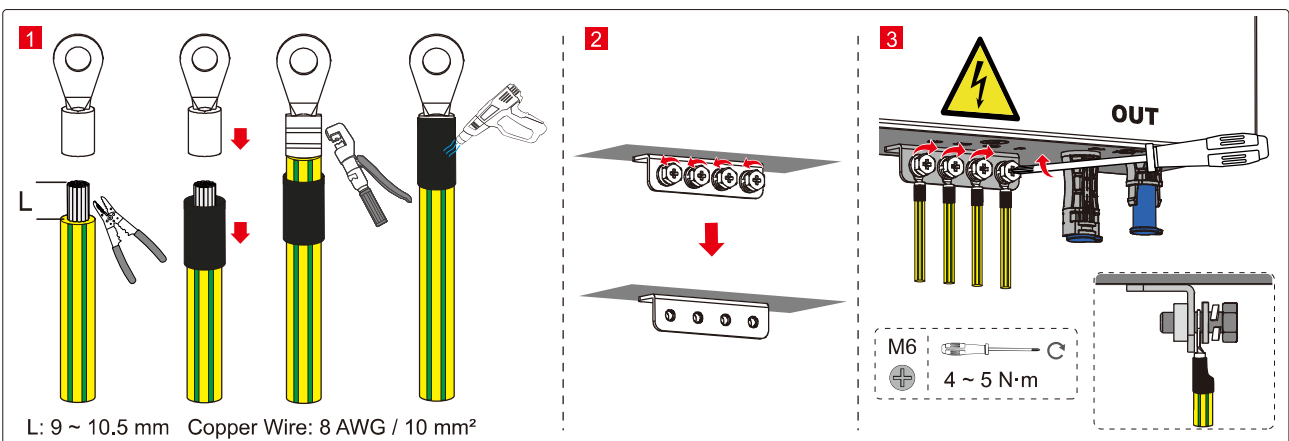


5.3.2 Electrical Connection

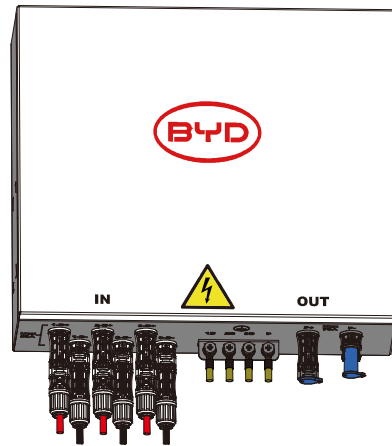

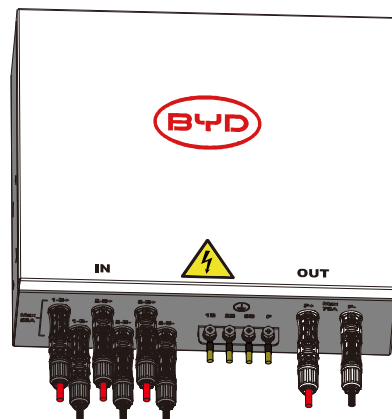

⚠ When crimping terminals, the crimping pliers die must not completely cover the viewing hole.

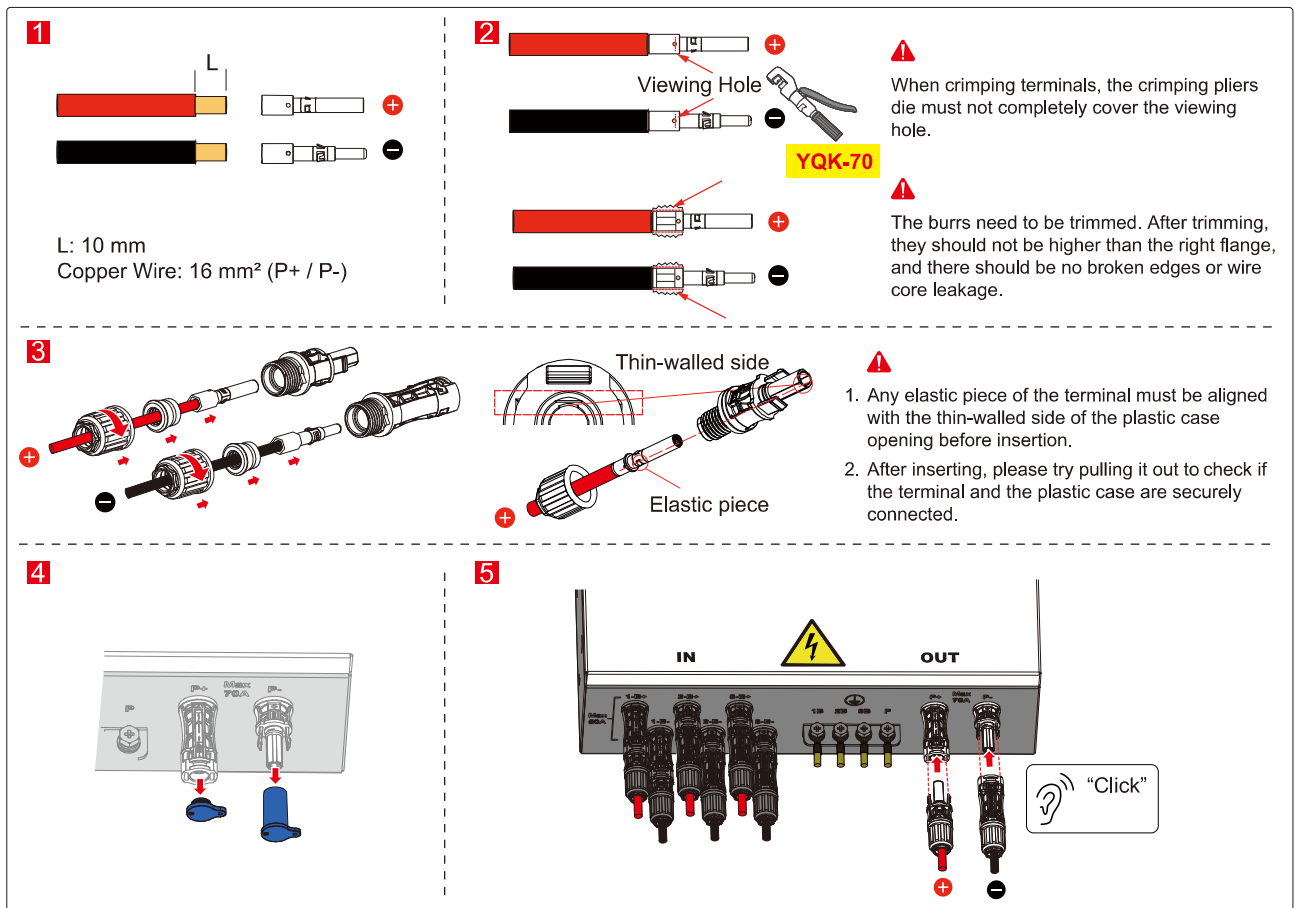
⚠ The burrs need to be trimmed. After trimming, they should not be higher than the right flange, and there should be no broken edges or wire core leakage.

⚠ 1. Any elastic piece of the terminal must be aligned with the thin-walled side of the plastic case opening before insertion.
2. After inserting, please try pulling it out to check if the terminal and the plastic case are securely connected.

5.3.2.3 Inverter Connection



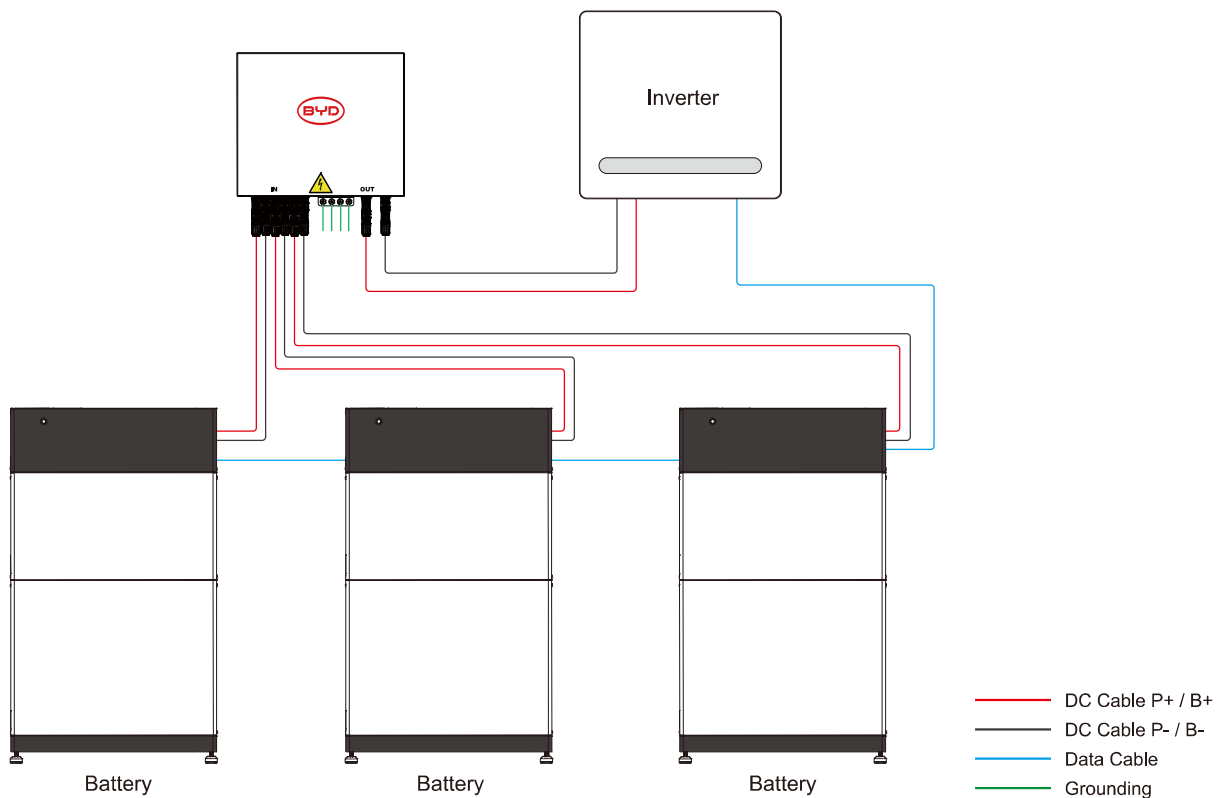

⚠ CAUTION

- The Battery-Box Combiner Box Plus can be used with the BYD Battery-Box HVS / HVM / HVB / HVM+ / HVS+ / HVE.
- Make sure the planned configuration meets the Premium HV Compatible Inverter list by BYD.
- The Towers have the same module quantity. Battery Towers of different models cannot be mixed.
- The SOC should be the same among all towers upon installation.



6 Storage

⚠ WARNING

- The Combiner Box must be stored indoors, and the package of the Combiner Box must be intact. It is strictly prohibited to store the products without packaging. Otherwise, BYD shall not assume any liability for the damage to the Combiner Box, the shortening in service life or other losses caused by such storage condition.

The product must be stored in a clean, dry, well-ventilated warehouse where the ambient temperature is maintained between -5°C and 35°C, relative humidity does not exceed 75%, and exposure to direct sunlight or corrosive gases is strictly avoided. Always store the product upright; never invert or lay it flat. Protect it from mechanical impacts, heavy pressure, and contact with corrosive substances.

7 Maintenance

⚠ CAUTION

- Do not perform maintenance on the equipment unless you are familiar with the contents of this manual and have the proper tools and test equipment.
- Professional technicians and operators shall be fully trained and have knowledge of safe operation and maintenance of the equipment. They should take adequate precautions and personal protective equipment while operating.
- The unit cannot be powered up again until all faults have been resolved. Failure to do so may result in more problems or damage to the device.
- Do not open the cover without authorization, otherwise there is a risk of electric shock.

It is recommended to periodically inspect the panel and check the following points:

Maintenance Item	Interval	Process
Monitor Operating Status	yearly	Check the Combiner Box for signs of abnormal heating, unusual odors, or physical damage. Promptly identify and address potential issues.
Temperature Monitoring	yearly	Check the Combiner Box temperature to prevent overheating. Inspect for loose connections or potential overload conditions
Regular Cleaning	yearly	Remove dust and debris from the Combiner Box exterior. Maintain good ventilation to prevent overheating caused by accumulated dirt.
Terminal Inspection	yearly	Check all wiring terminals for oxidation, corrosion, or looseness. Clean, tighten, or replace terminals as necessary to ensure optimal electrical conductivity.
Seal Inspection	yearly	Check the condition of the Combiner Box sealing gasket. Replace it promptly if aged or damaged to prevent moisture ingress.

8 Decommissioning

8.1 Disassembling the Combiner Box

⚠ DANGER

Danger to life due to electric shock when touching live components of the Combiner Box .

Observe the following safety rules when disconnecting:

- Turn off the inverter and battery switch in sequence to ensure that the system enters the shutdown state.
- The DC cables connected to the battery and inverter may be live. Do not touch non-insulated cable ends.
- Check if there is still voltage or current on the Combiner Box.
- Cover or isolate any adjacent live components.

⚠ CAUTION

- Risk of burns from touching hot components.

Steps:

1. Turn off the battery system.
2. Disconnect the input cables
3. Disconnect the output cables.
4. Disconnect the grounding cables.
5. Disassemble the Combiner Box.

8.2 Disposing of the Combiner Box

Dispose of the Combiner Box in accordance with the applicable disposal regulations for electronic waste.
